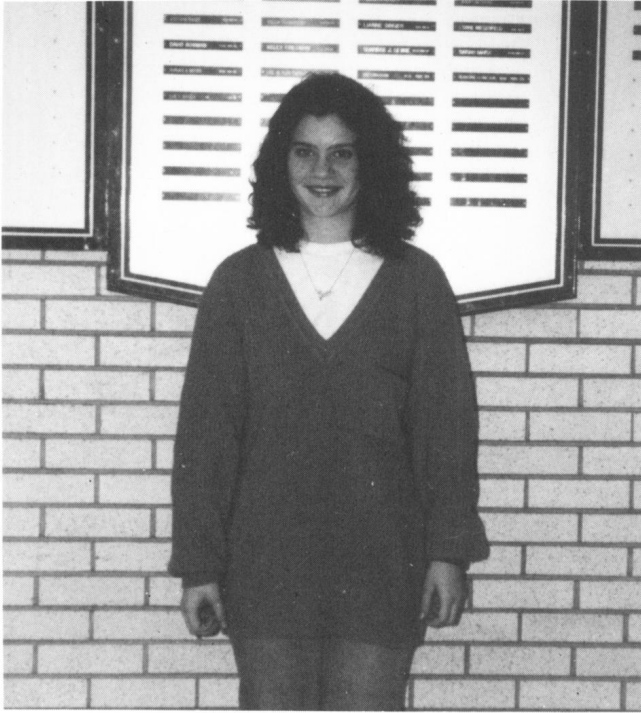


STRATFORD TRIP

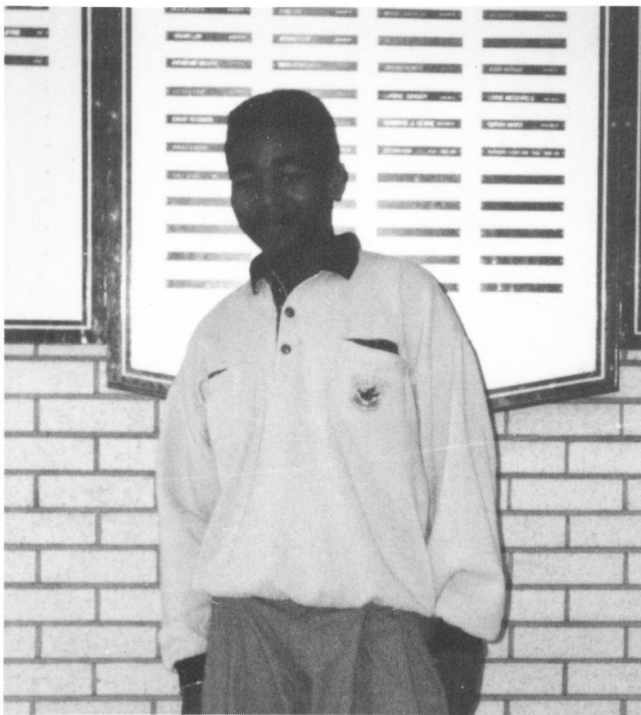

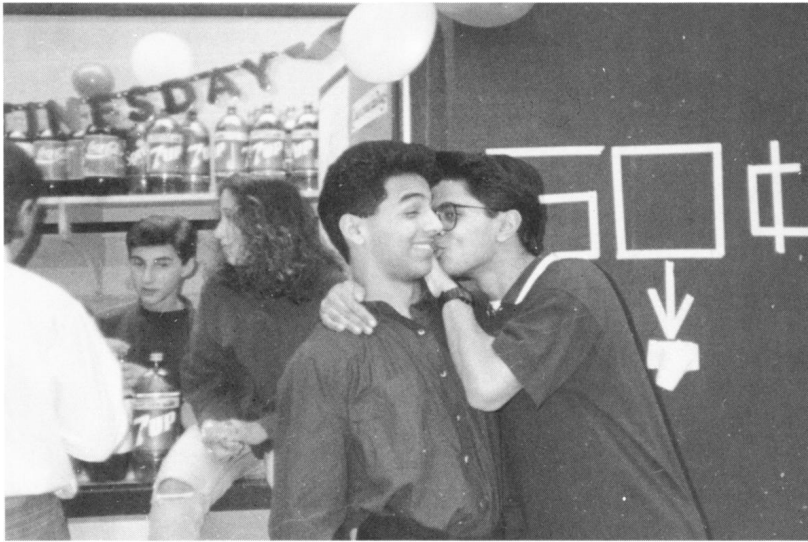
WINTER CARNIVAL



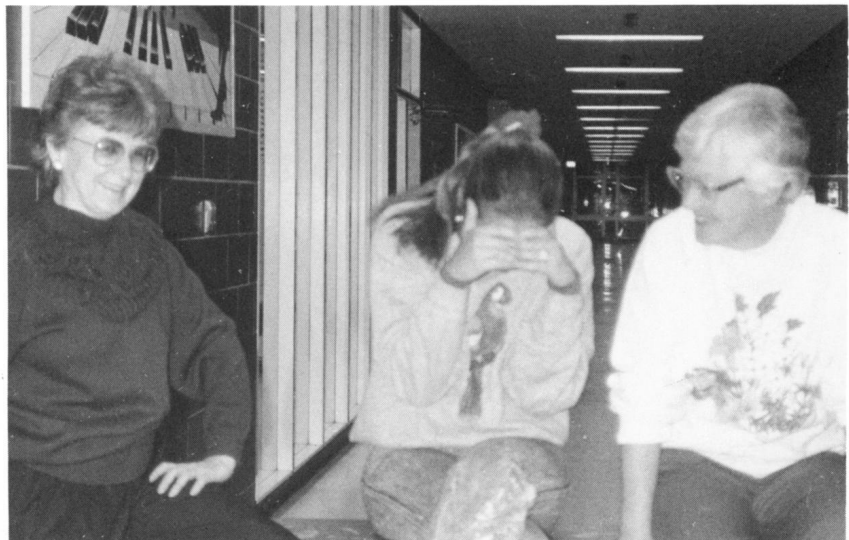
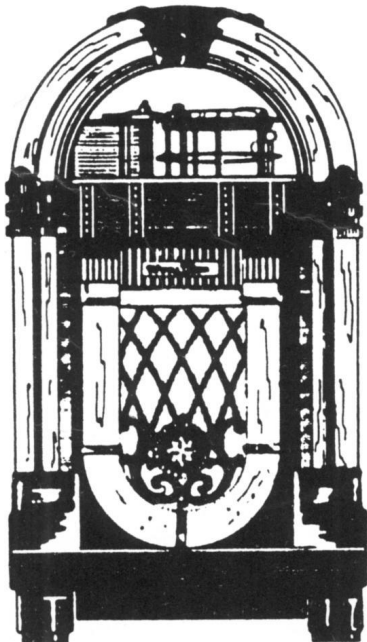

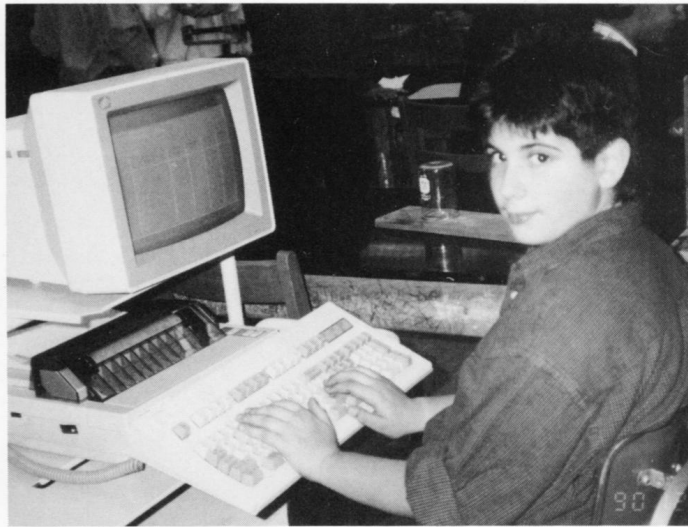
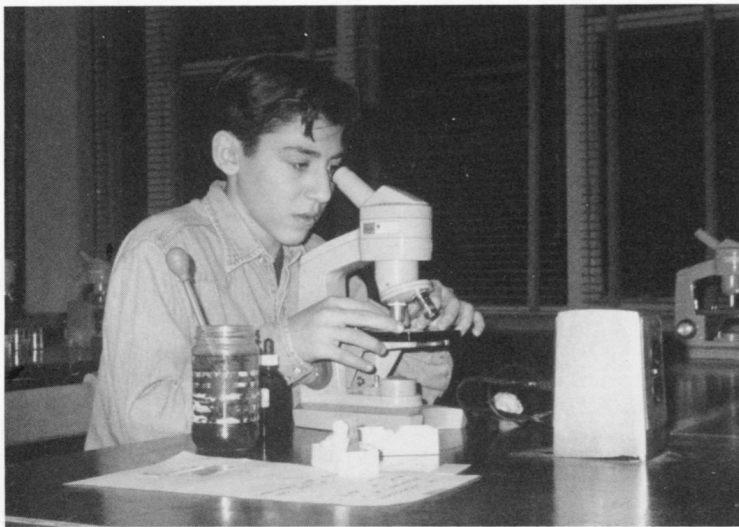
In all the carnival was a great success and everyone had a good time. Thanks, Student Council for pulling it off.



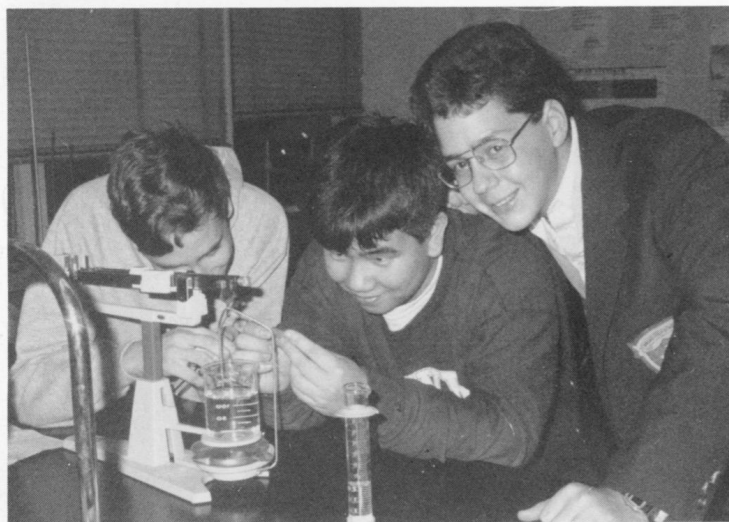
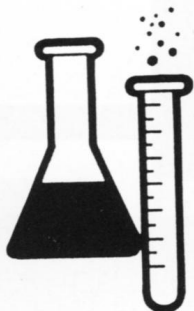
