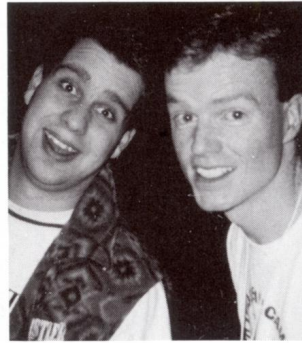
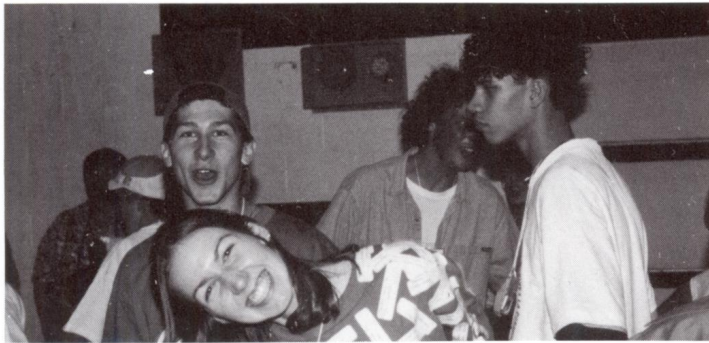
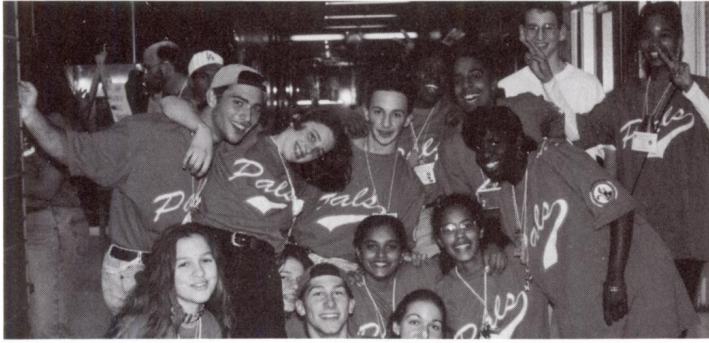

This year Wagar hosted a conference for students from all over Canada. The Leadership Conference was a success thanks to the participation of all leadership students. We made a difference!

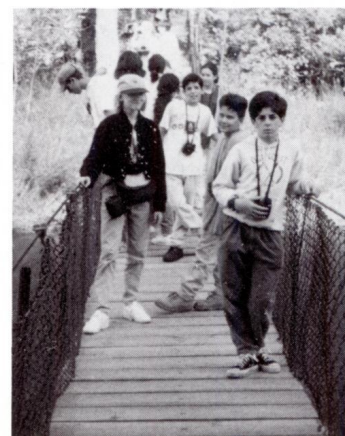

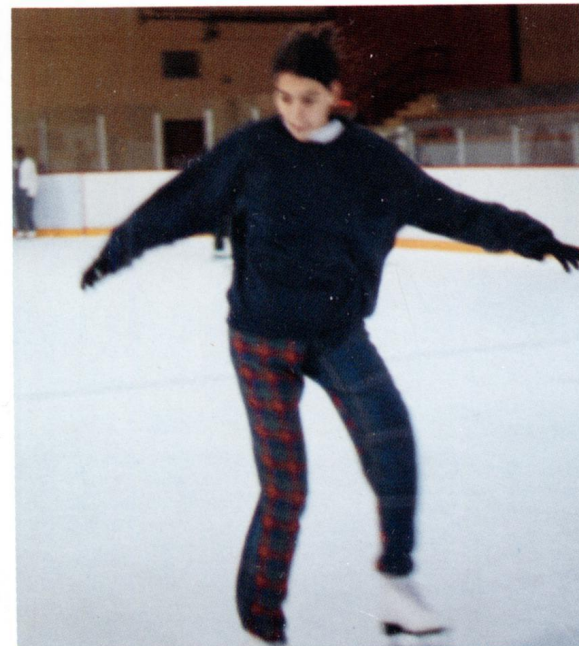
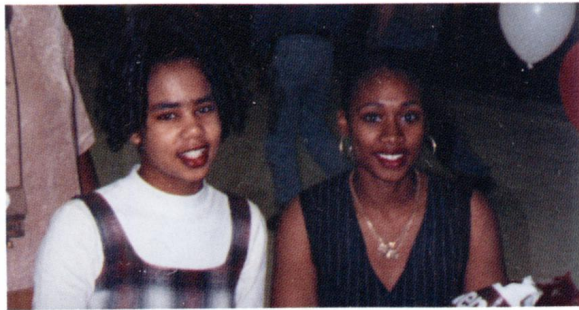
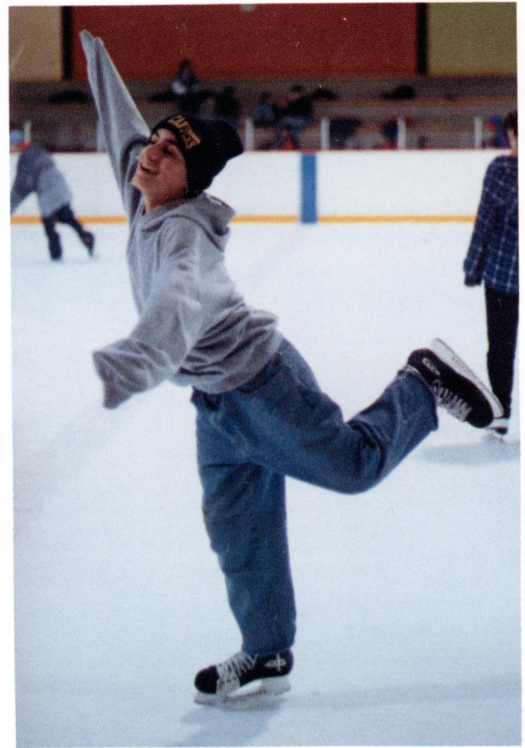
SKI TRIPS



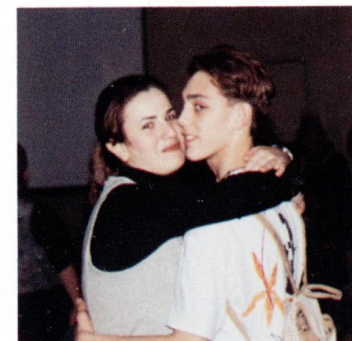

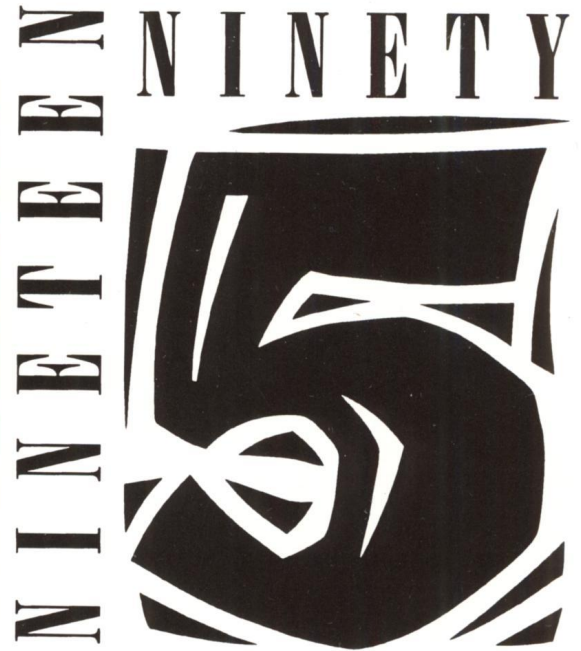

We wish next year's council all the best.

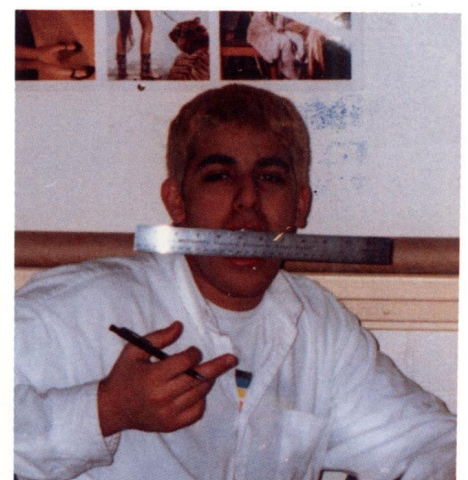
