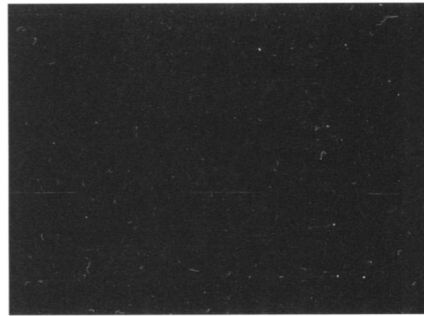




WHO DUN IT?

came upon the school...

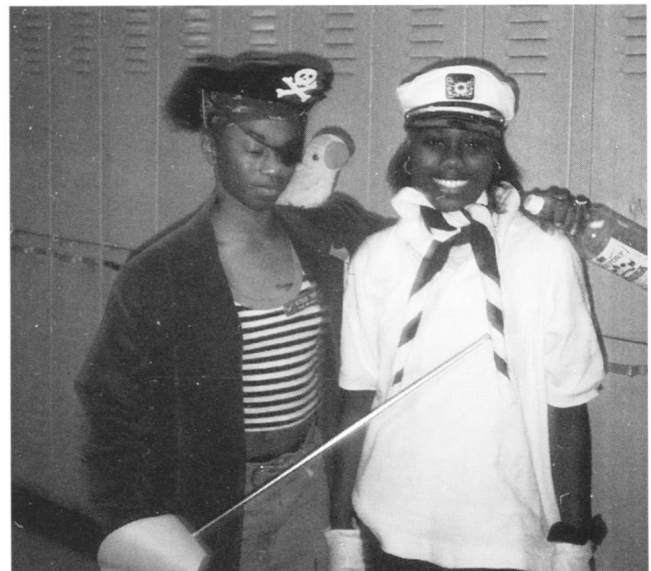


When the power came back on,

into the matter quickly...



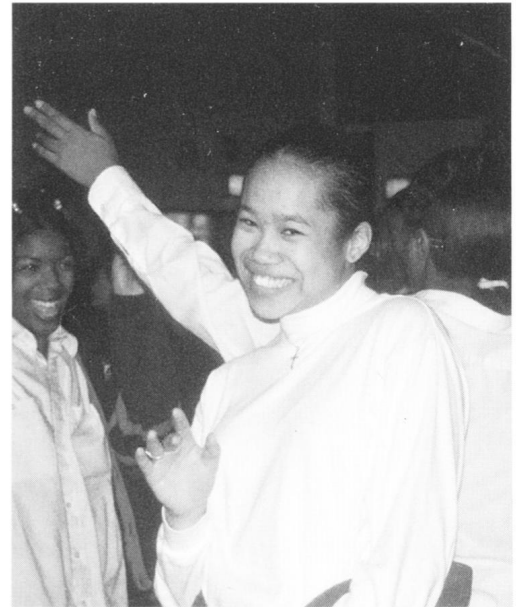
And suspect 1 + 2 were questioned...after questioning, they

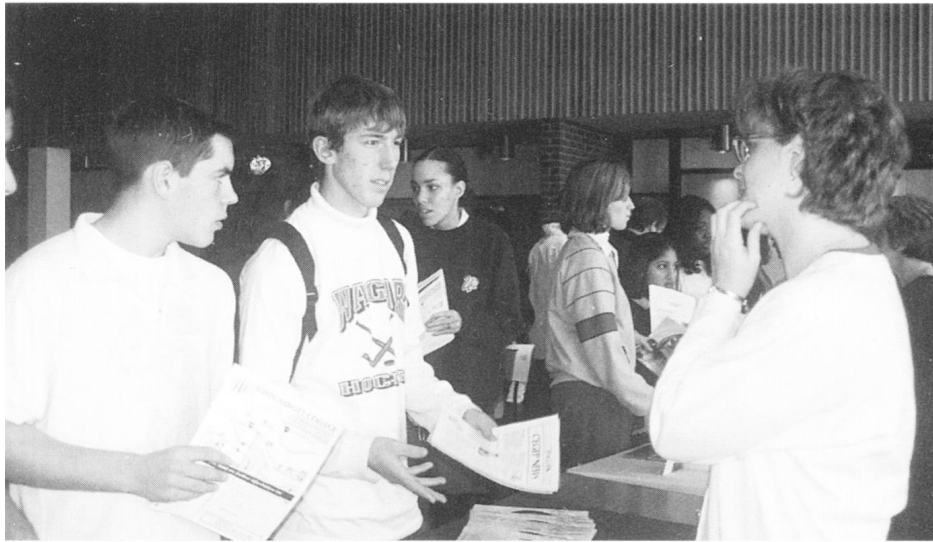




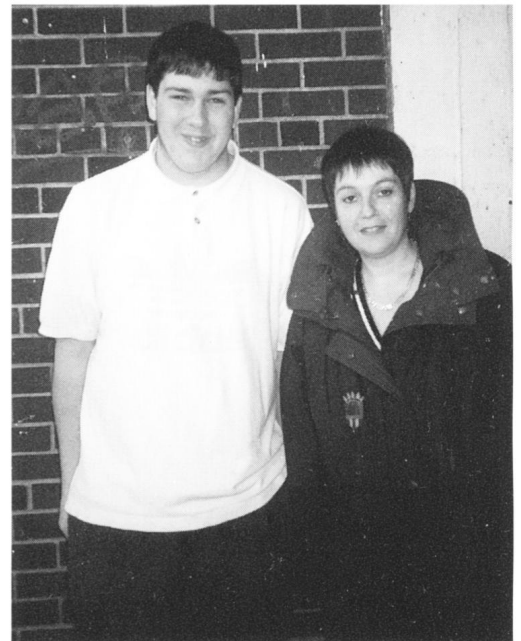
Some students held a meeting about this matter... over lunch.

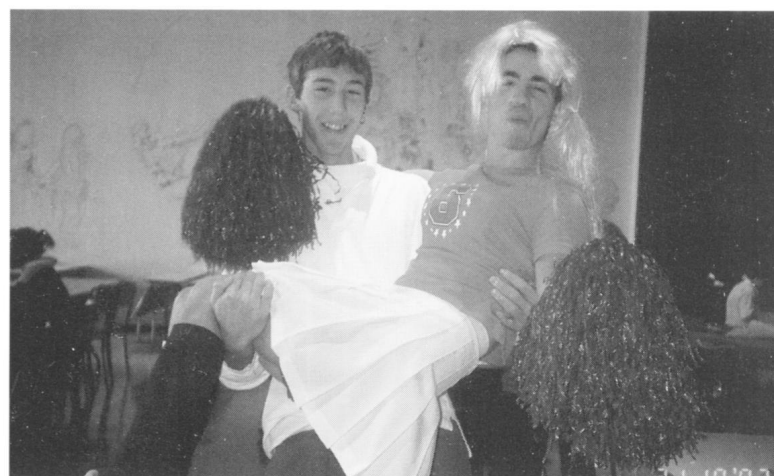
Students file into the cafeteria to see what is offered.

One just stood out from the crowd by just staring at the representative from... which CEGEP?



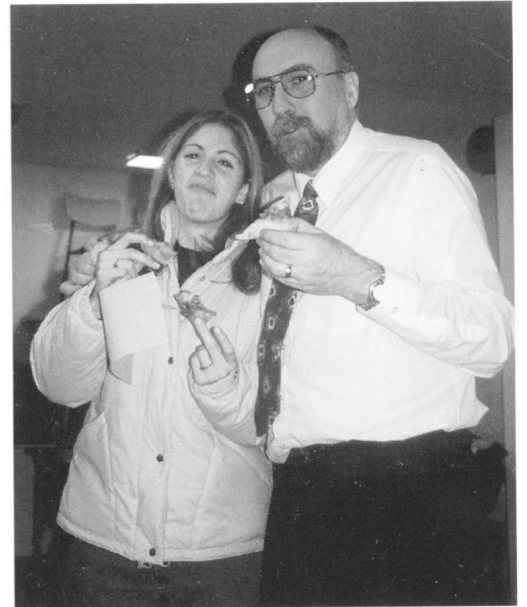

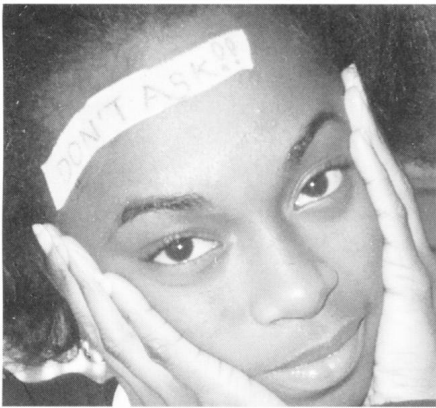
To an outsider, it would look like Wagar was a normal school...

Finally, after sometime (and money) later we got a whole bunch of volunteers who took us around...



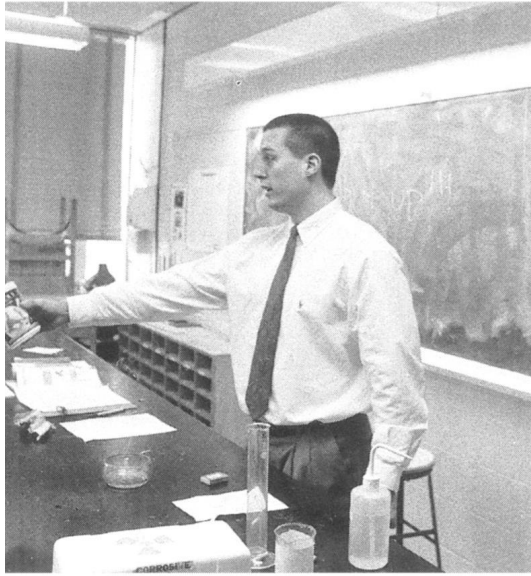

But most of all thank you to the members of the student council:

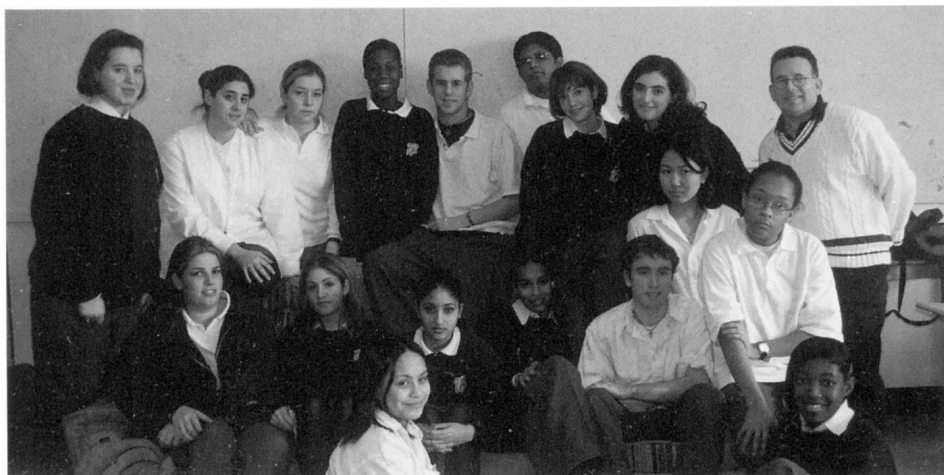

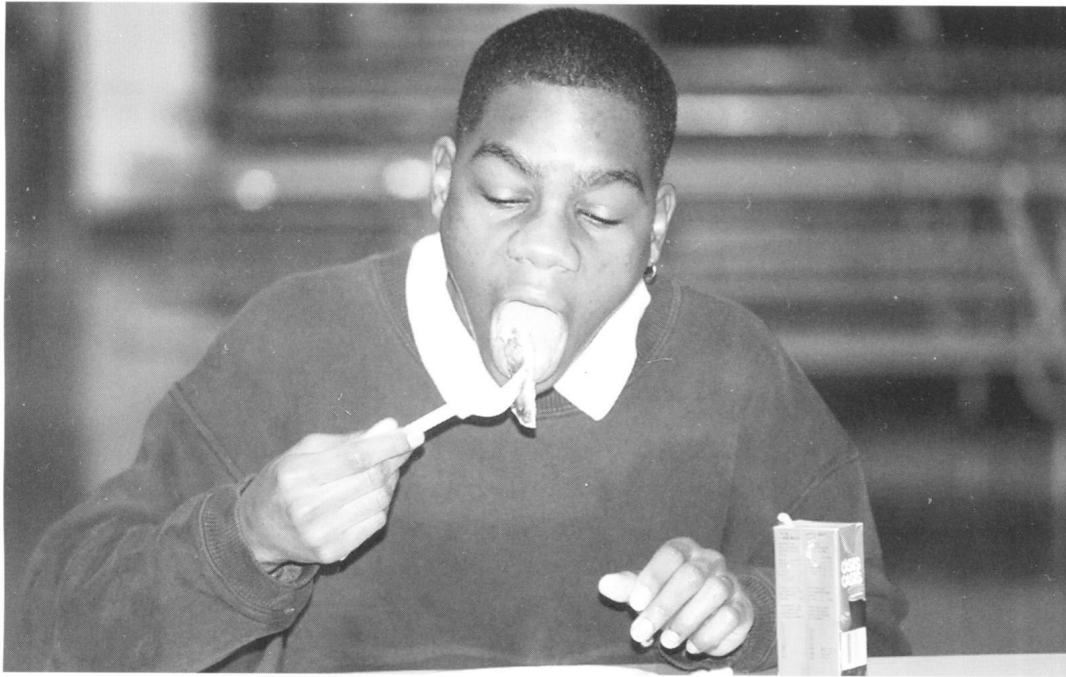
