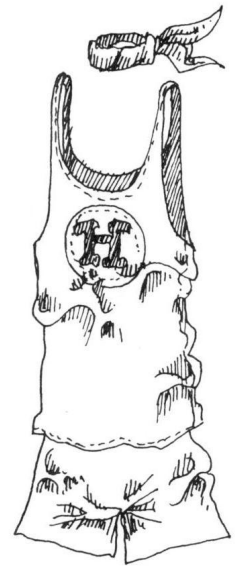
## TEACHERS TAKE KIDS
