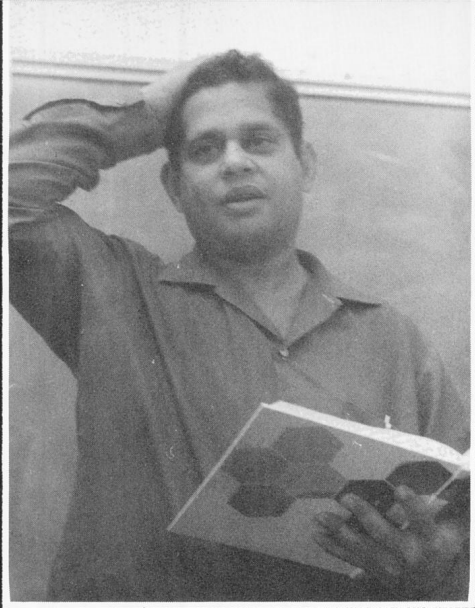
Much credit must also be given to Shelley Katz for providing the rehearsal music and to Miss Lois Henderson, Musical Director and Rhonda Richter, drummer.

An enormous amount of effort helped to make "Oliver" an unqualified success. Lucky are those who were able to attend the opening night and two subsequent performances Sunday and Monday.

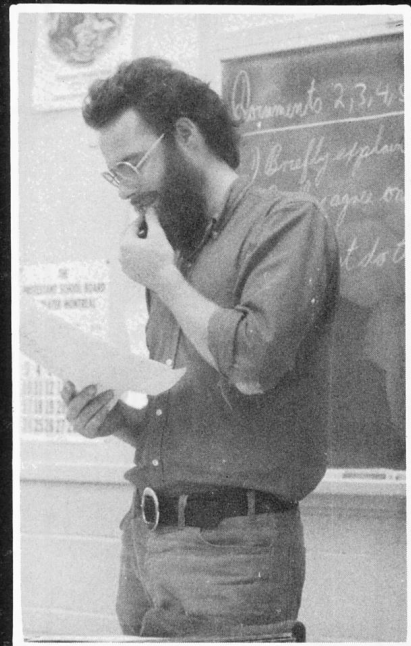
