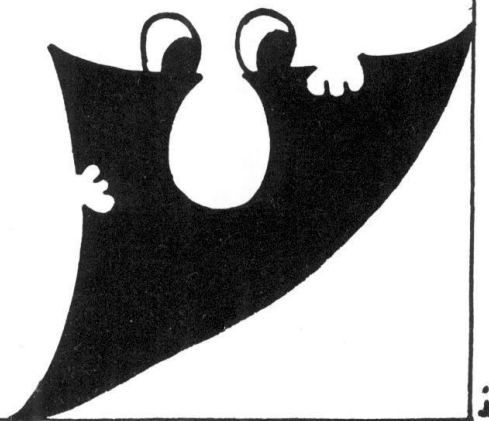
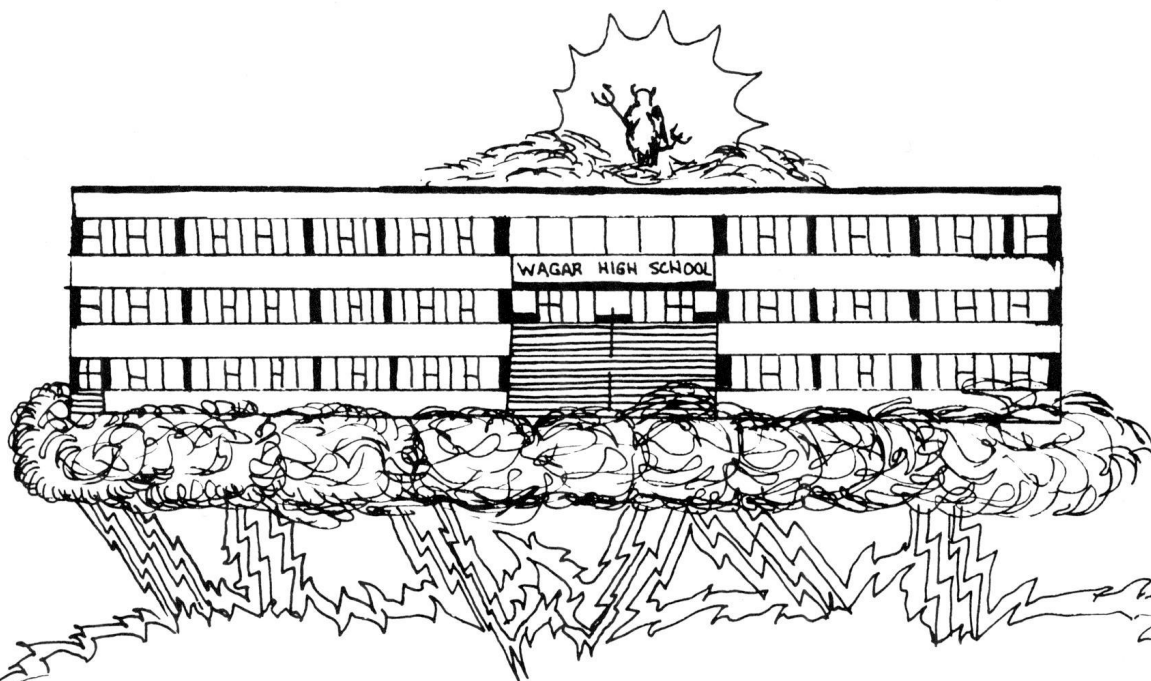

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Editorial:

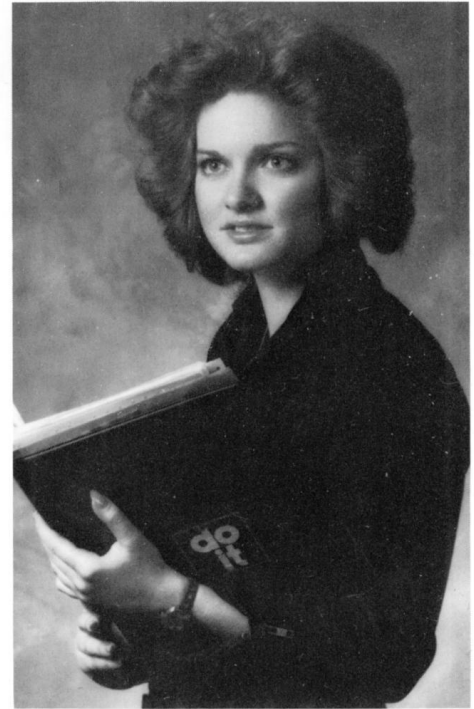
I've wanted to write this editorial for as long as I can remember... and now that it's my chance, I'm not so sure about what I want to say.

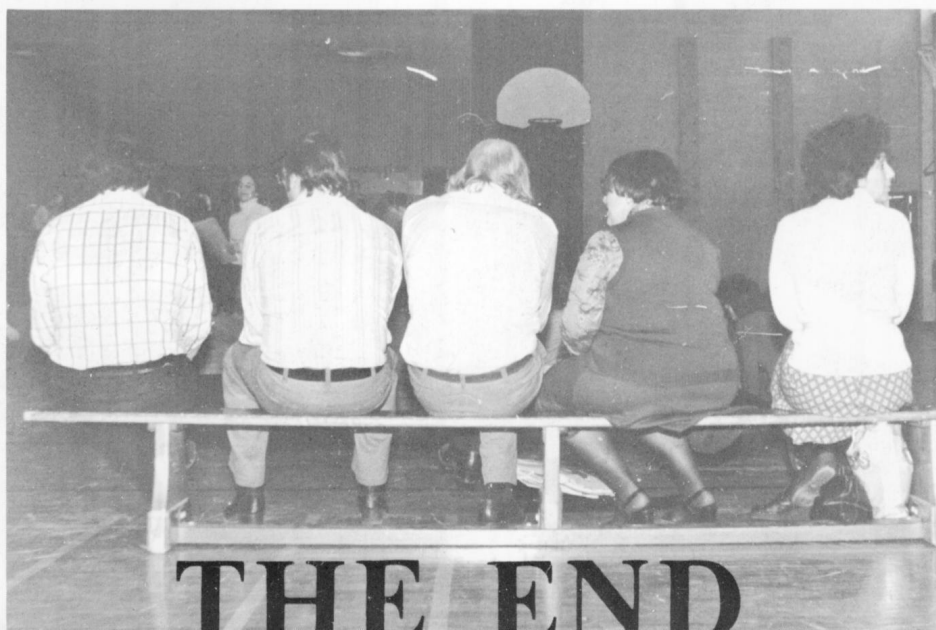


REACH FOR THE TOP
