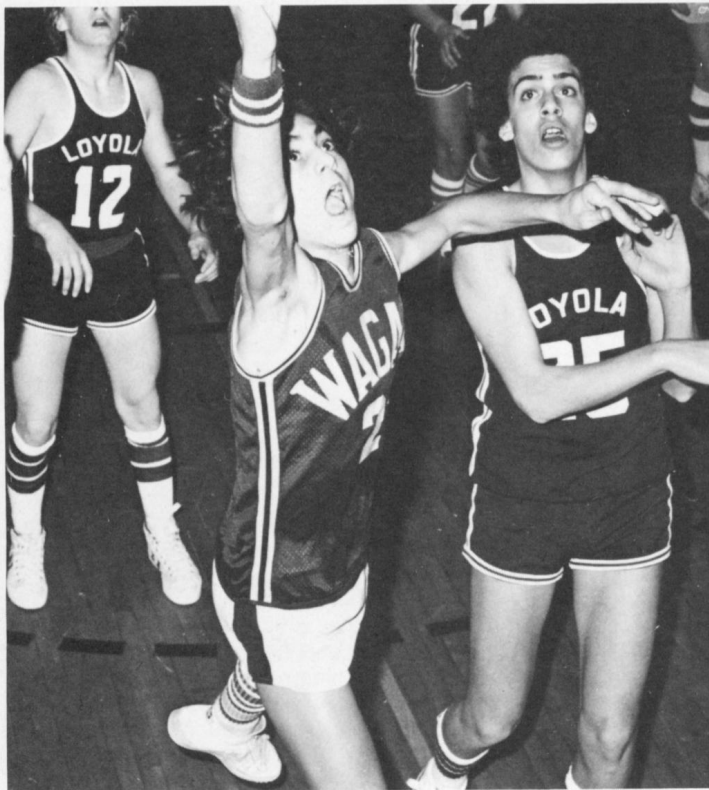
Wagar's Big Shots

And the blood began to seep.

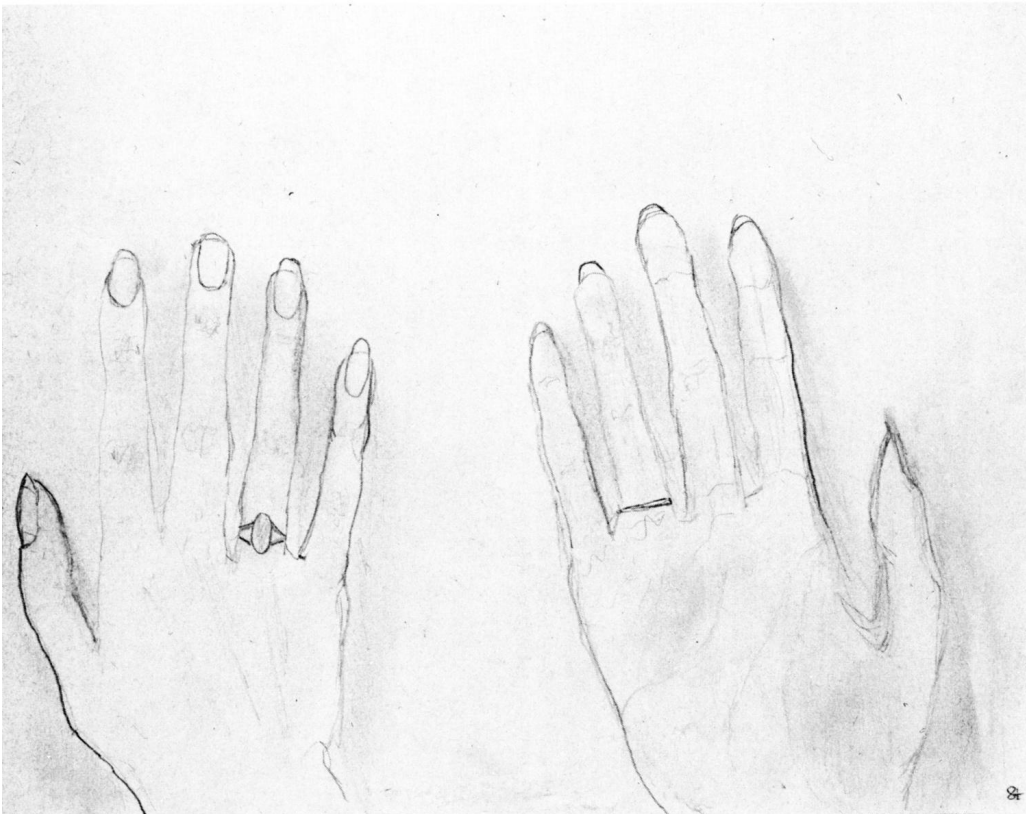

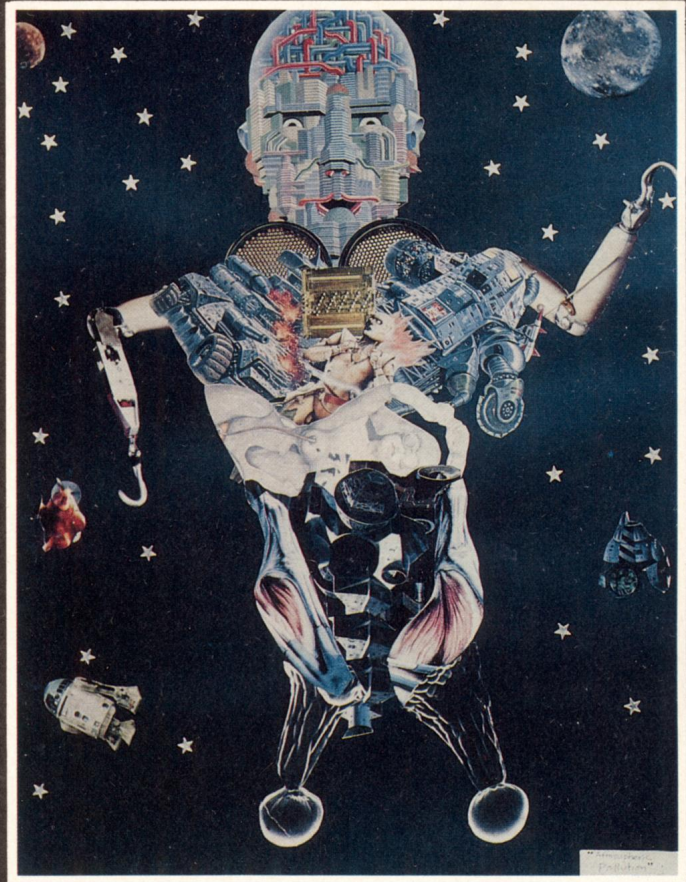
You walk down the halls

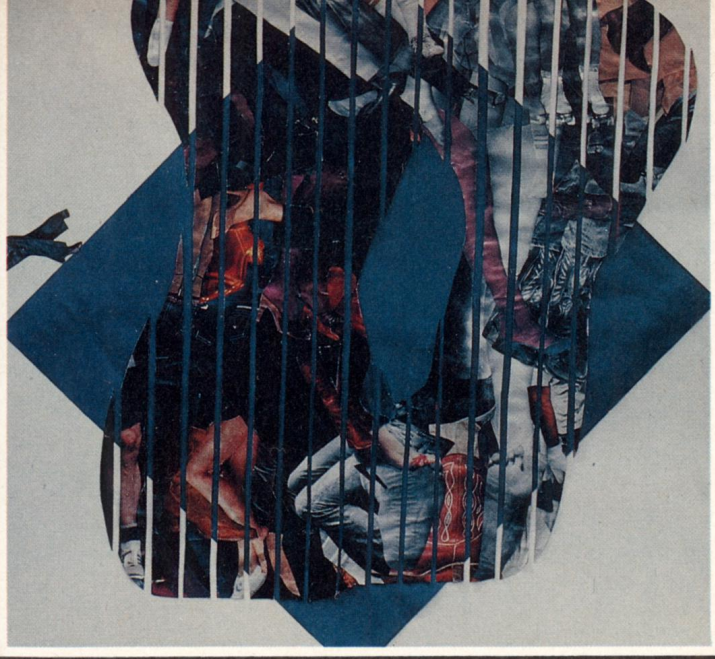

And the fog-horn vibrations from the metal ones;

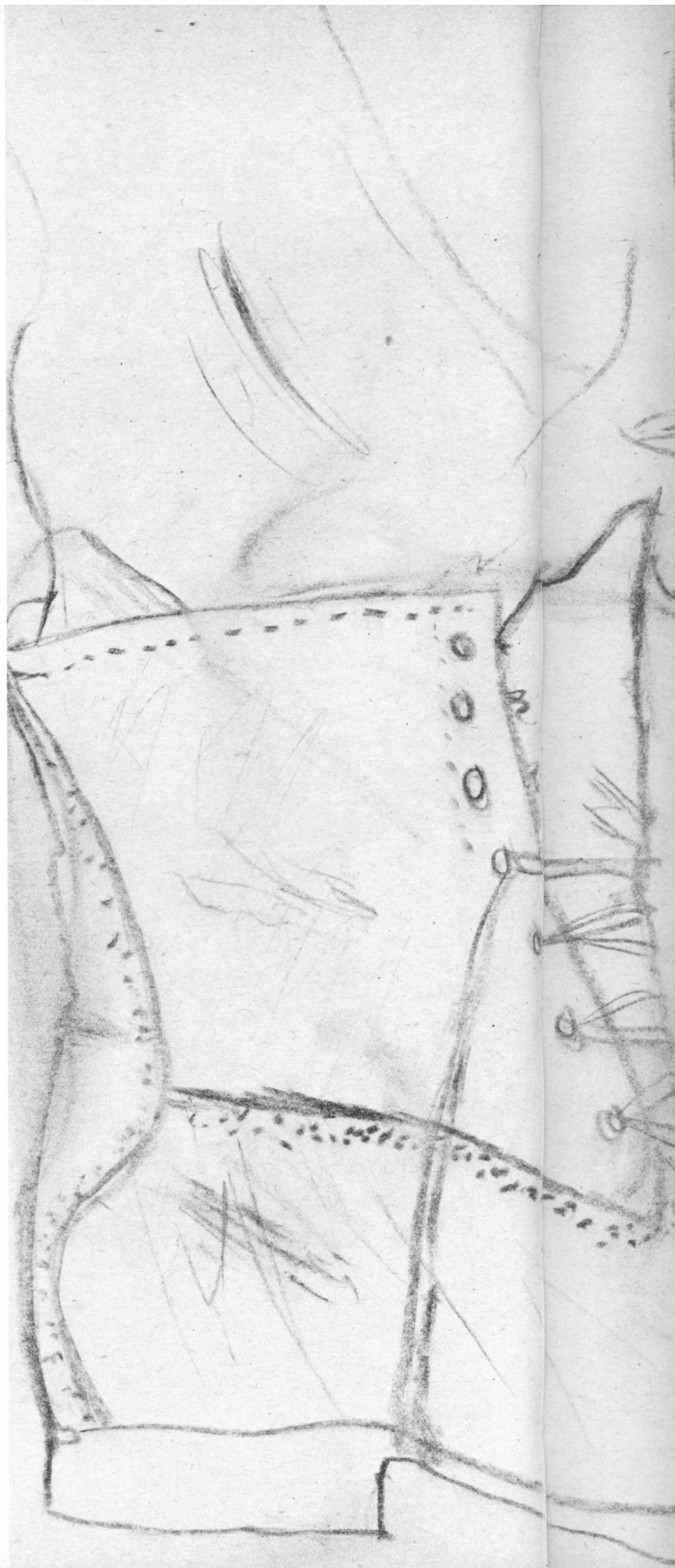
Long rulers banging metal filing cabinets
(Deep drum-roll) for attention.

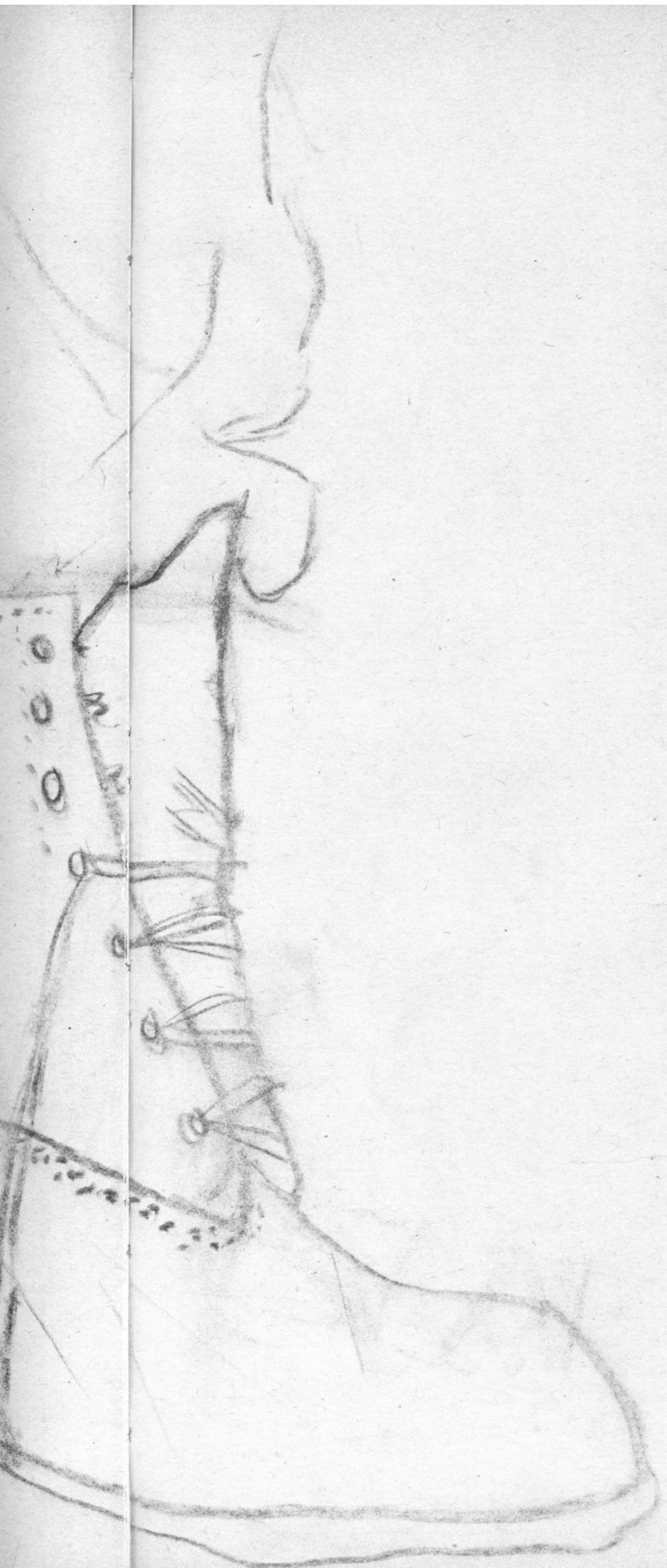
A lone instrument in the music room.

And I leave them behind.



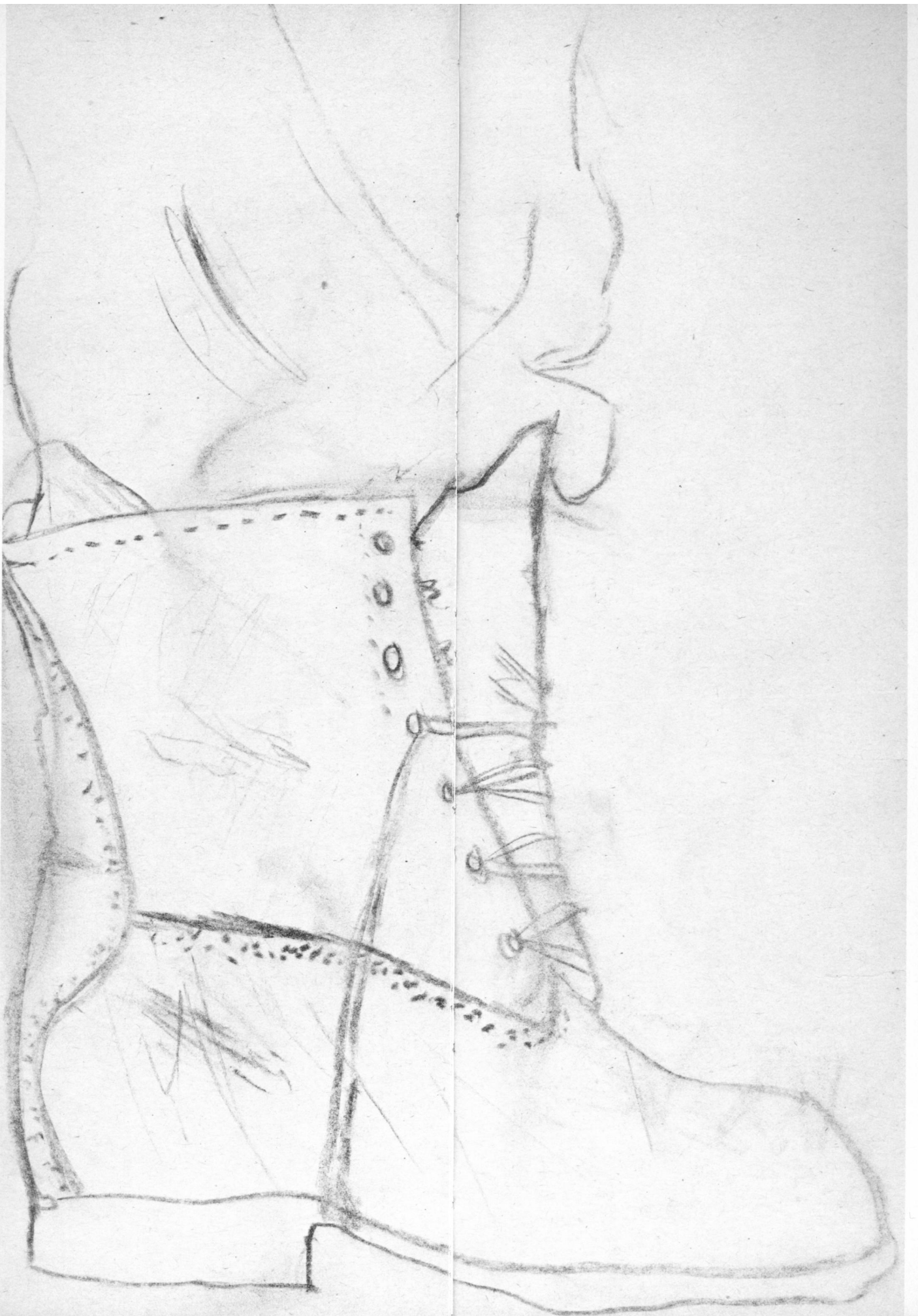


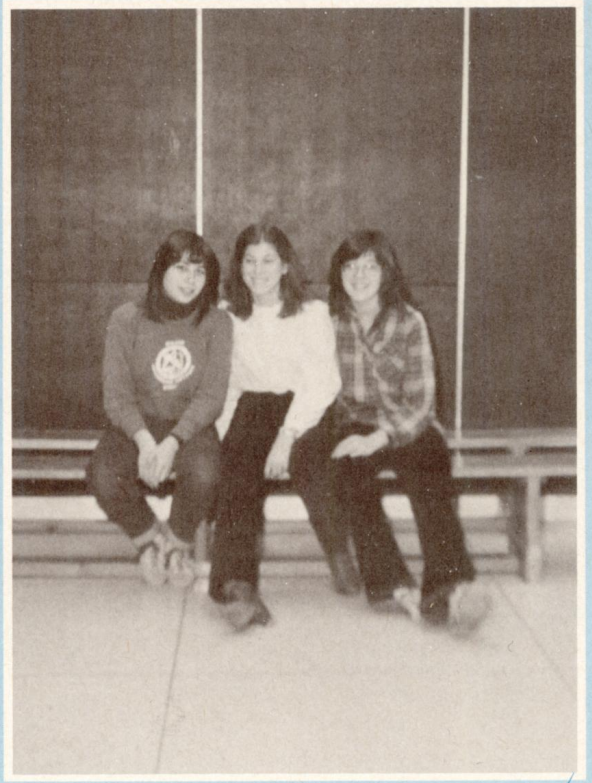
THE CONVERSATION

very much.

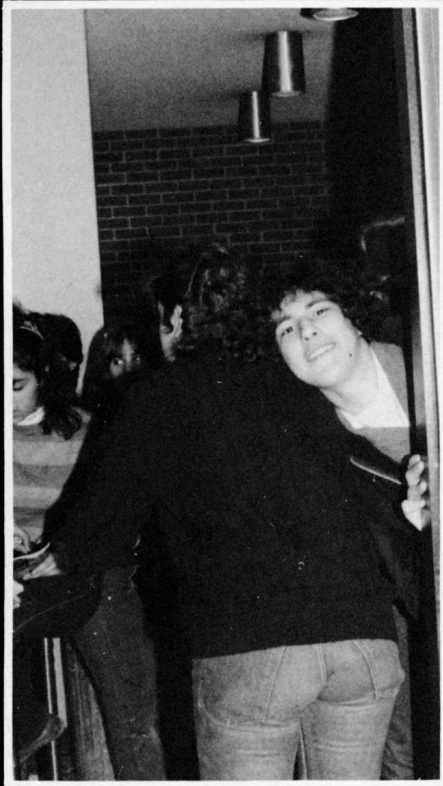
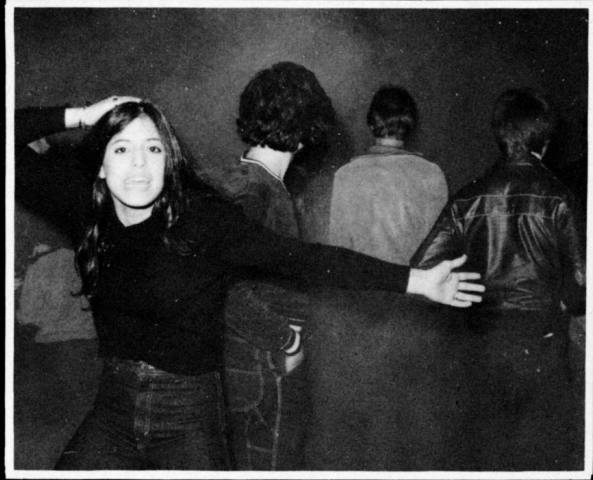

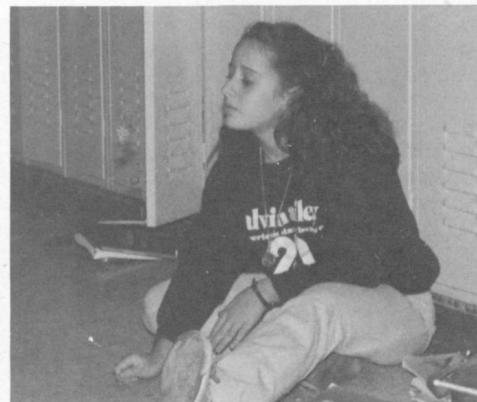

Anticipating the Queen!

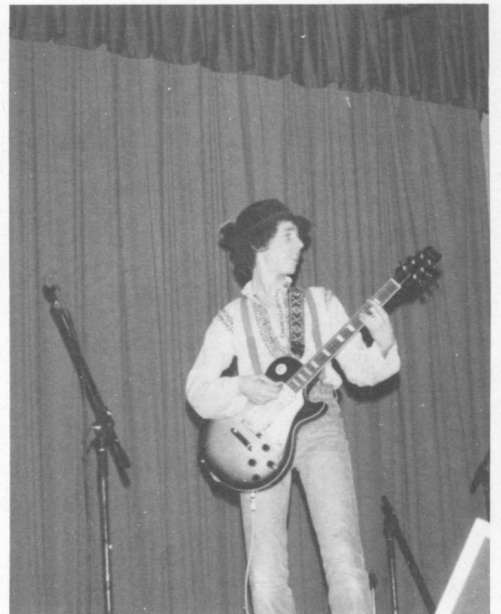

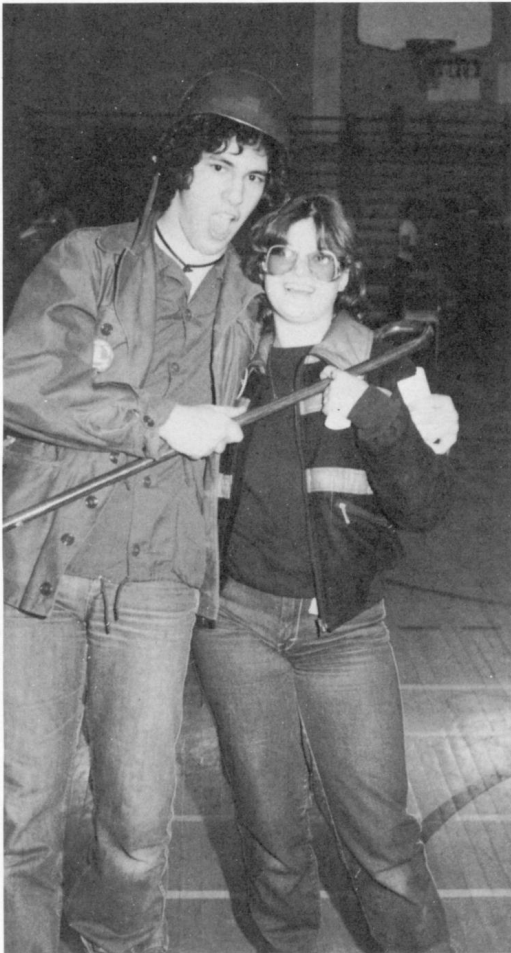

BAND-AID

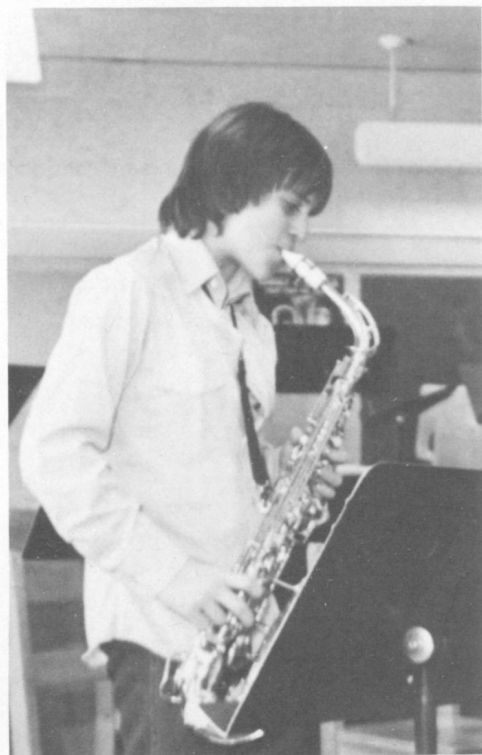

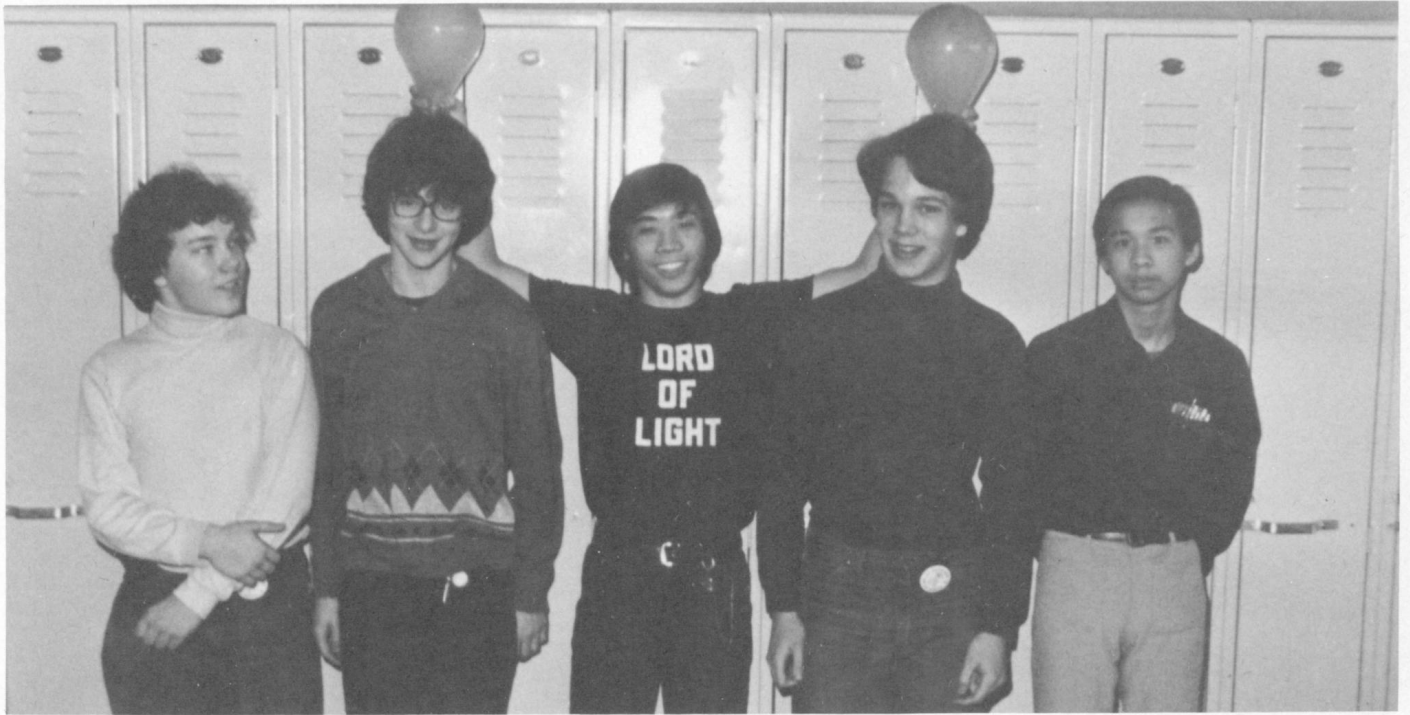

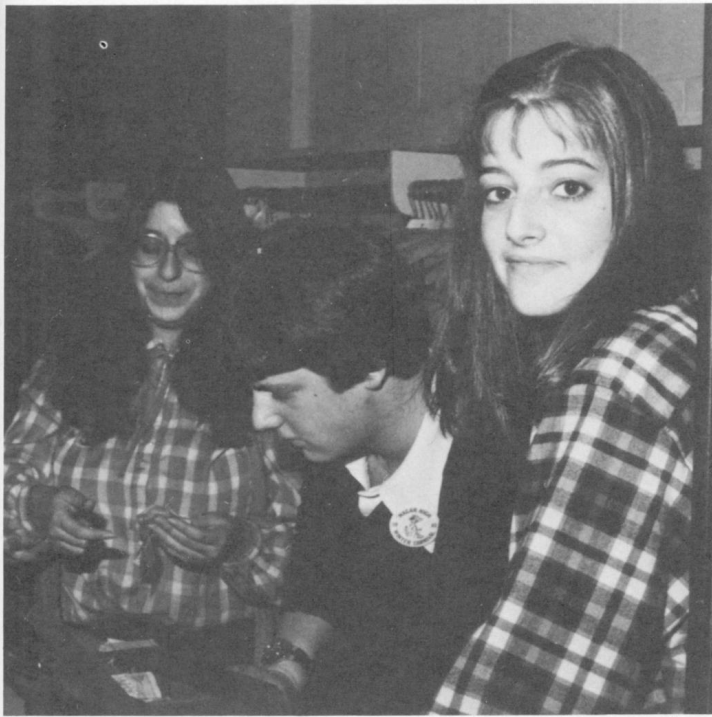
- 1) Volumes and volumes of pseudo-history

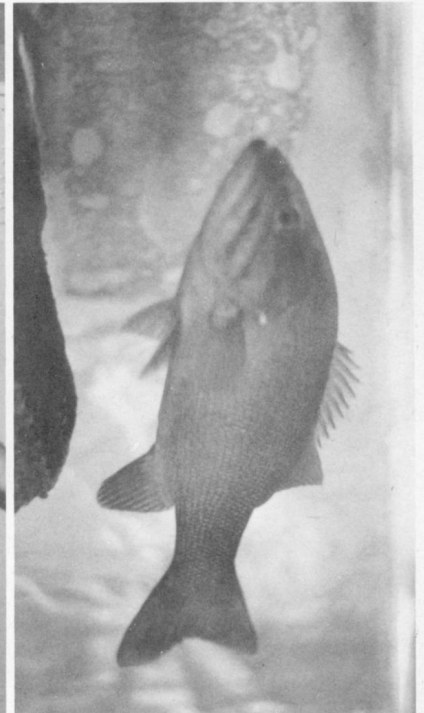

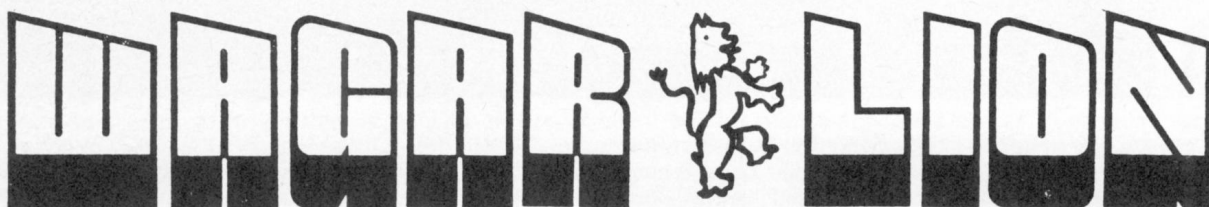


GRADUATING CLASS ORGANIZATION

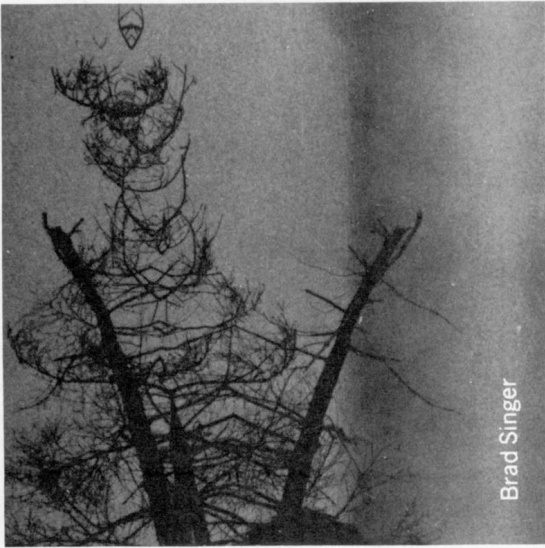
A NOTE ABOUT OUR MINISTER
