Seeing magic only they can see.

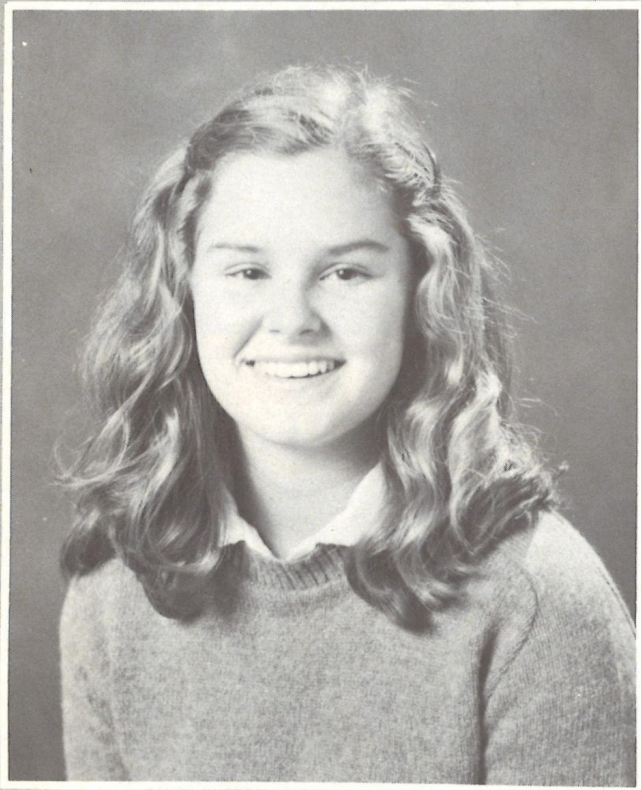
The parents watch on with bored faces

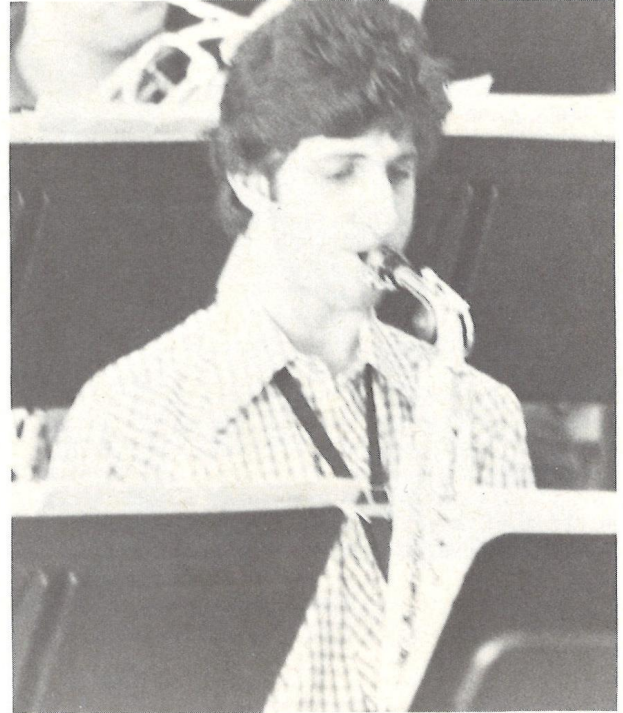


MUSIC MAKERS

Just then, the door opened. The interruption brought the little mother back to reality. Her doll lay on the floor, and her mother - the real mother - stood menacingly in the doorway.

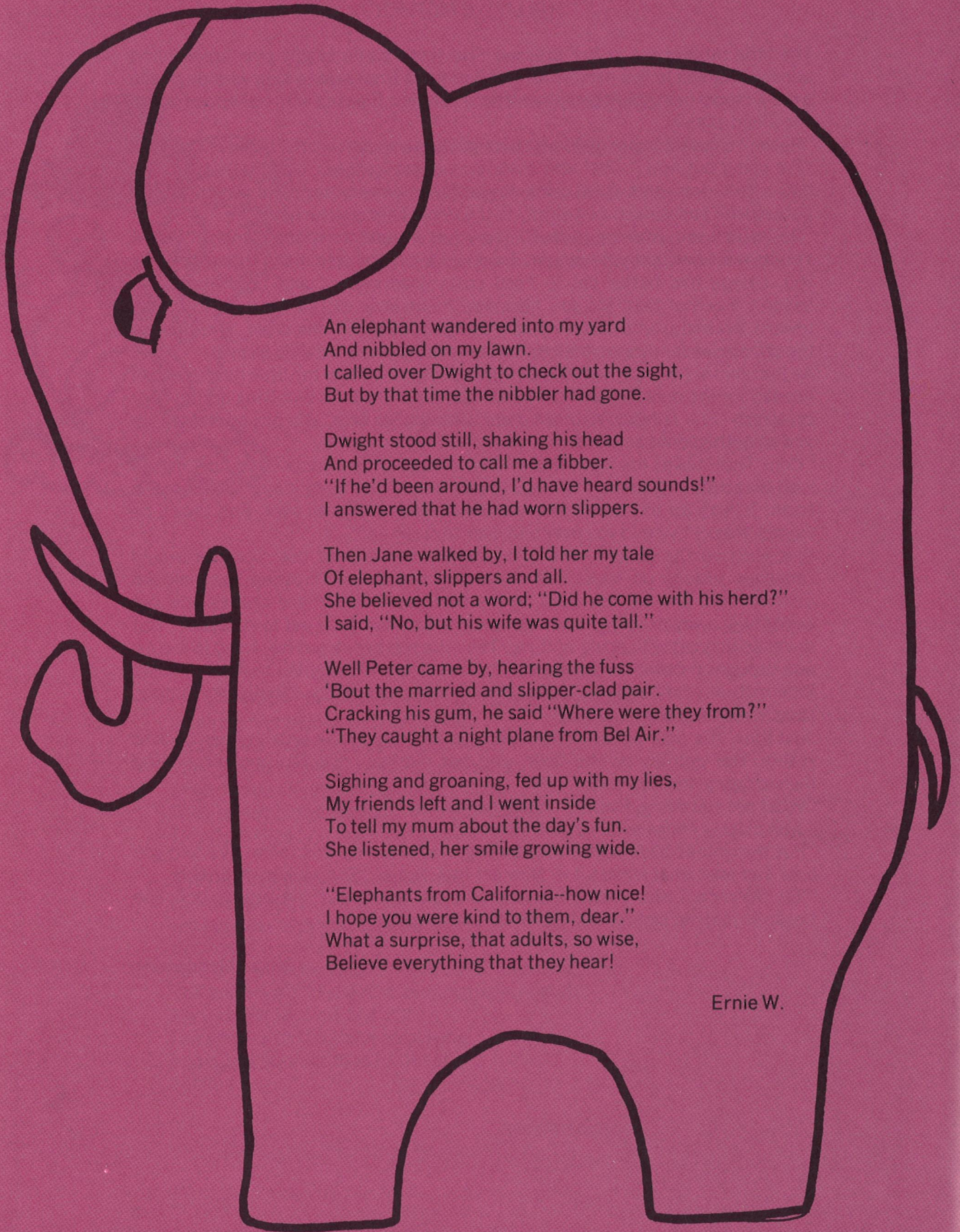
"What are you doing, Rosie?" she demanded.
