THE PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

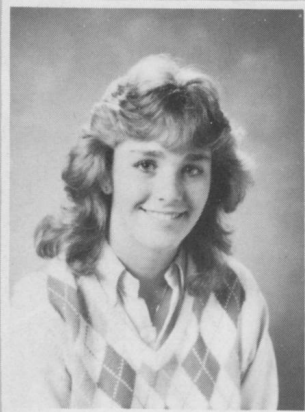

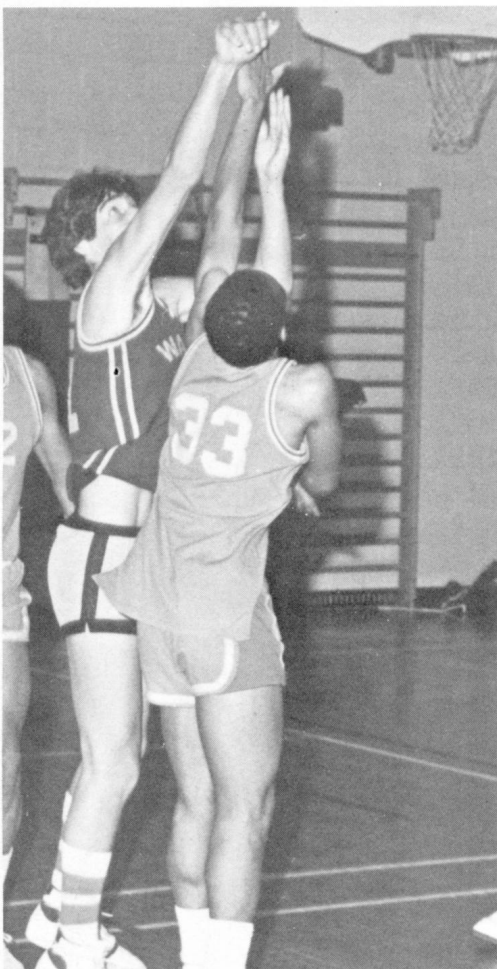
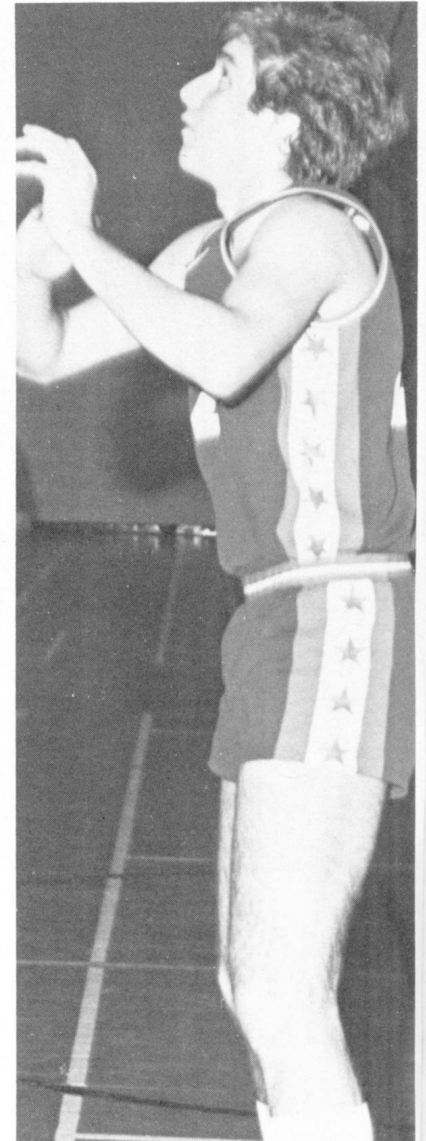
Midget Girl's Volleyball

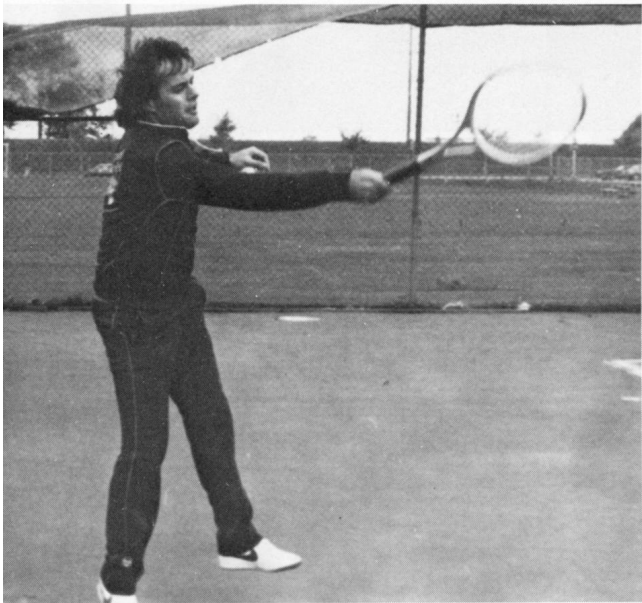




Tennis Clinic

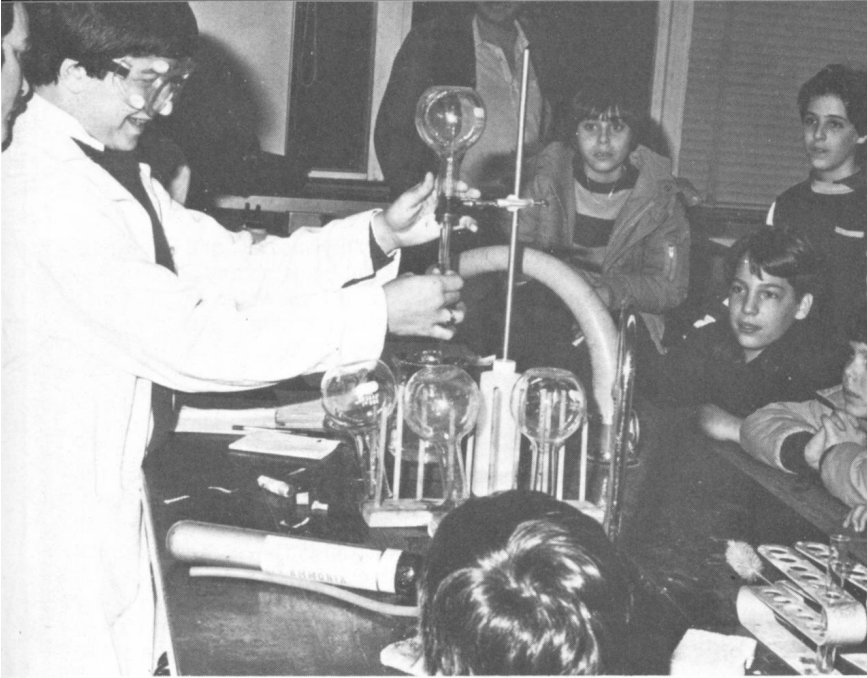


TENSION was mounting backstage as we watched the many anxious models prepare themselves for the show that they had worked on for months.
