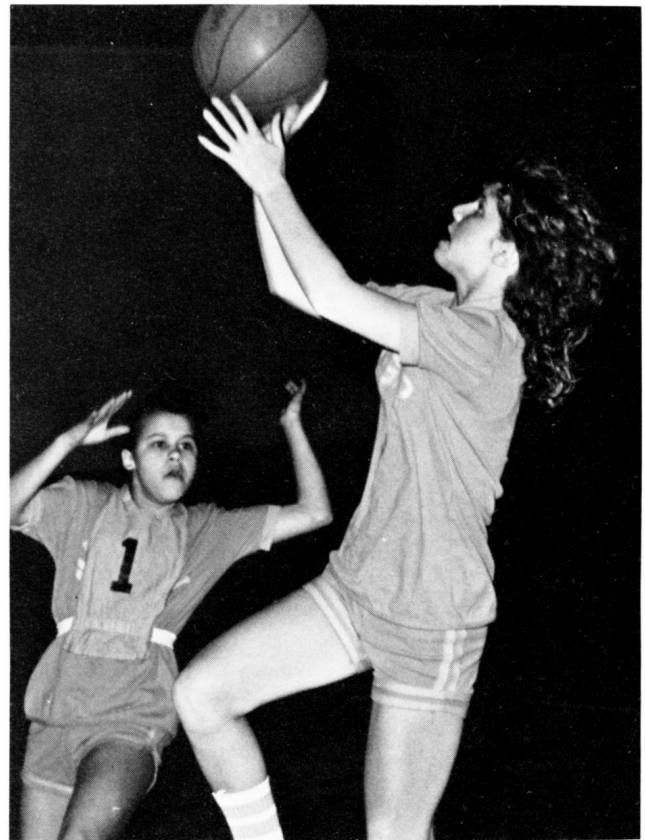
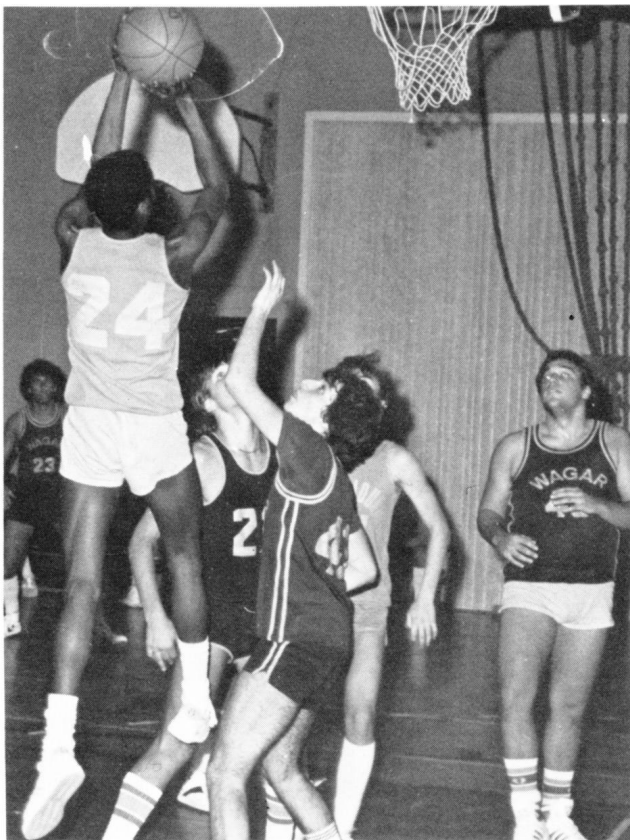
## Juvenile Boys

## Track and Field



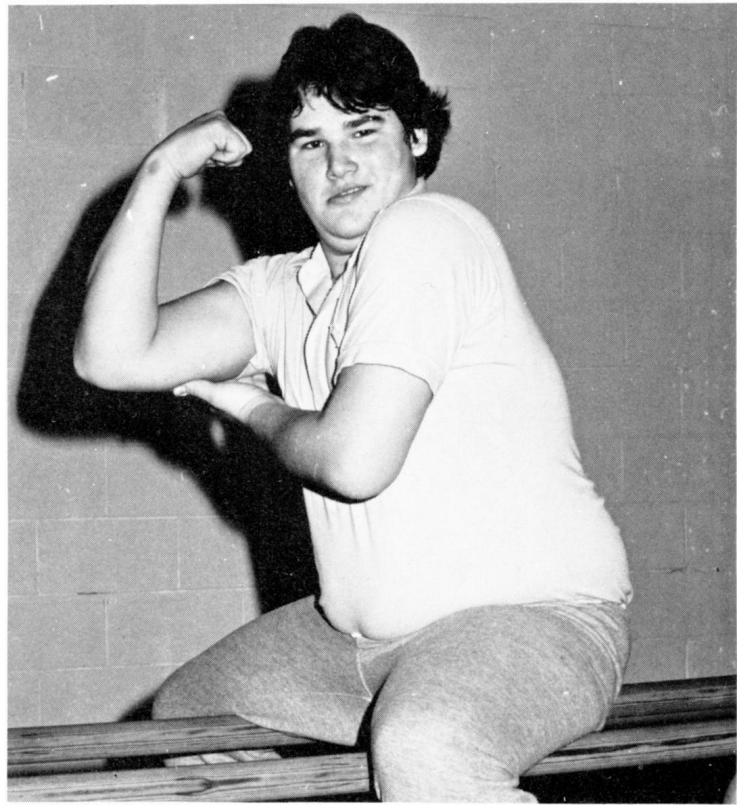

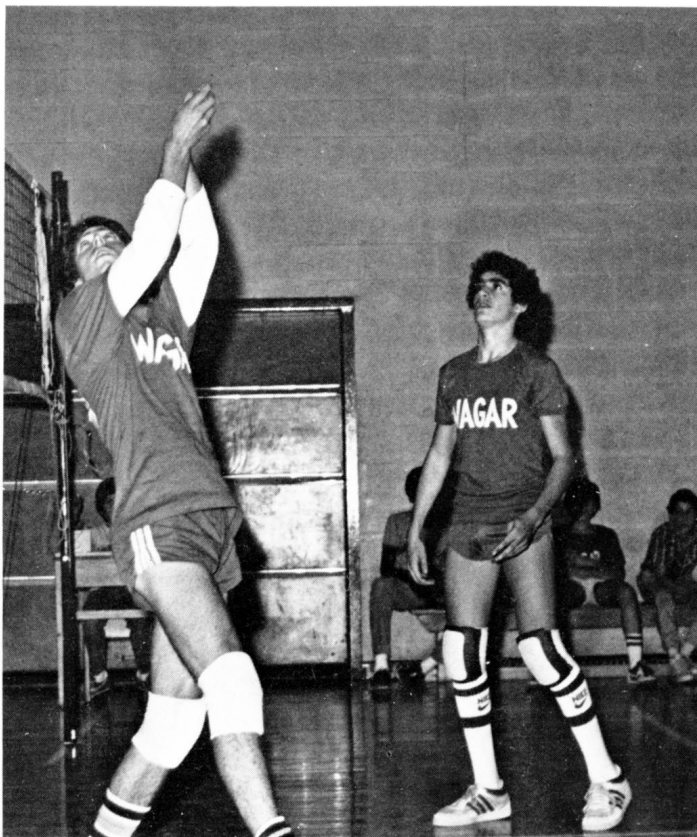
