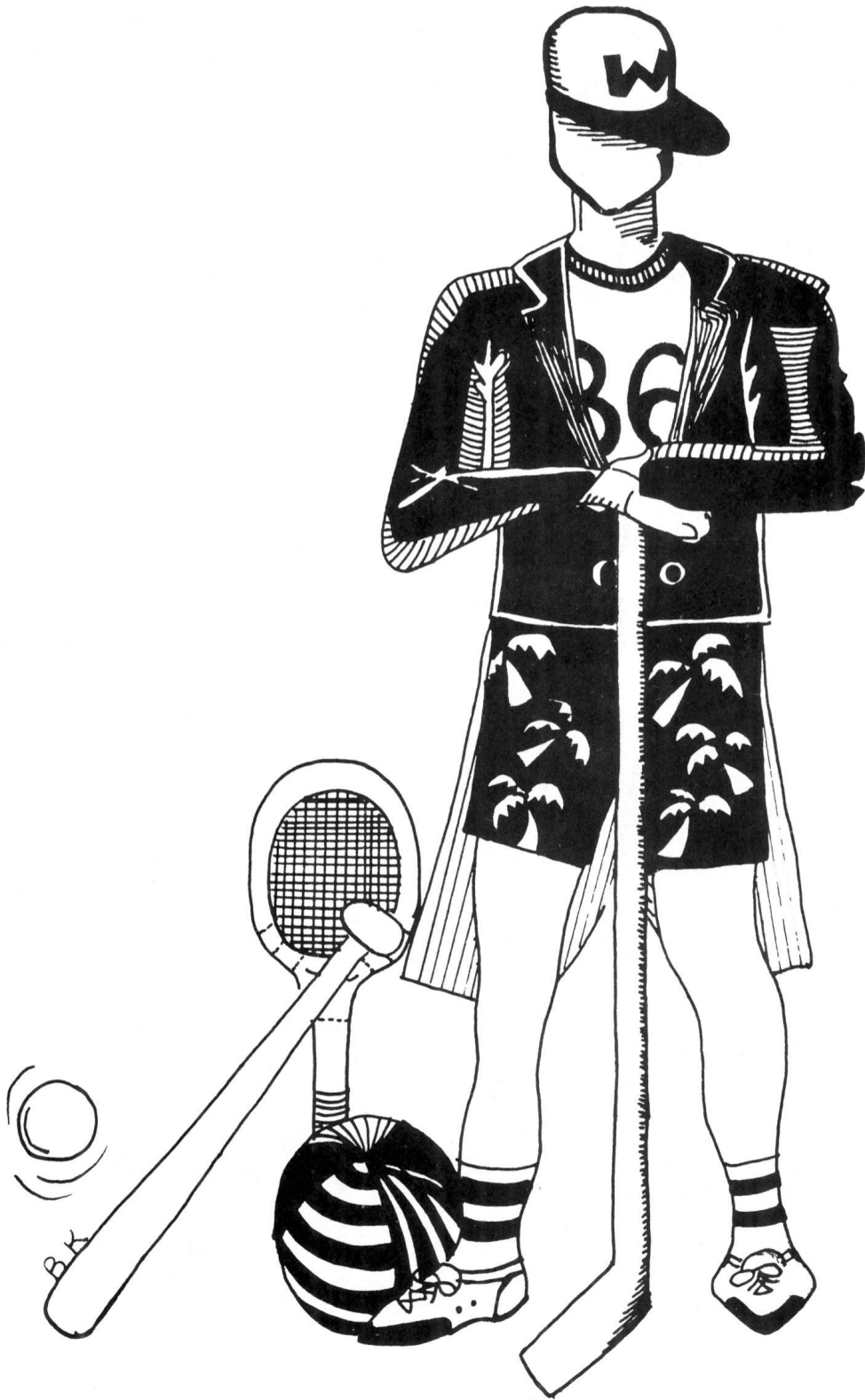

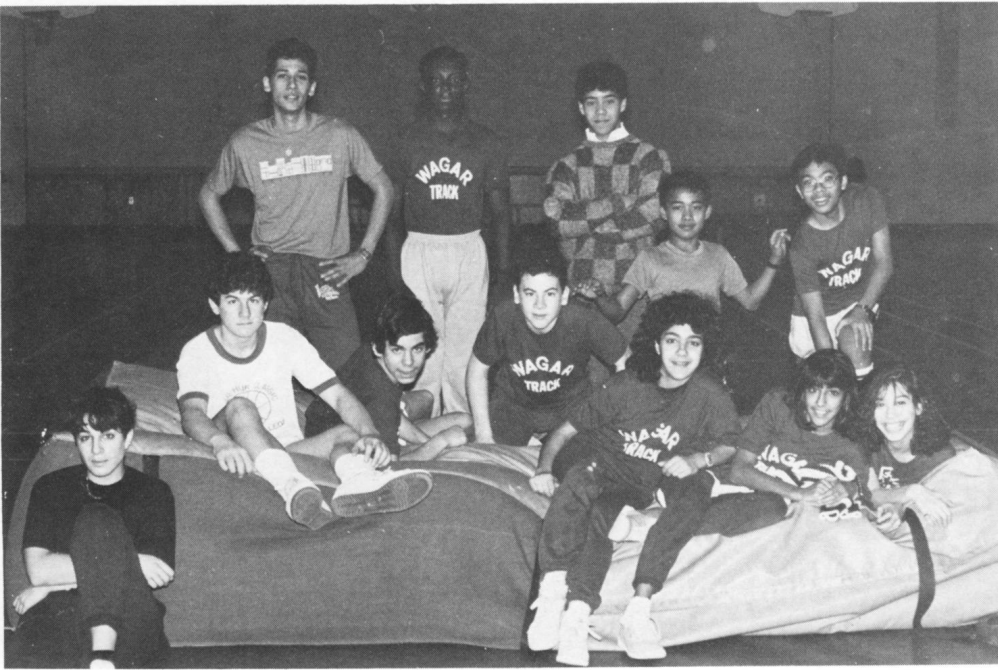

SKI TEAM

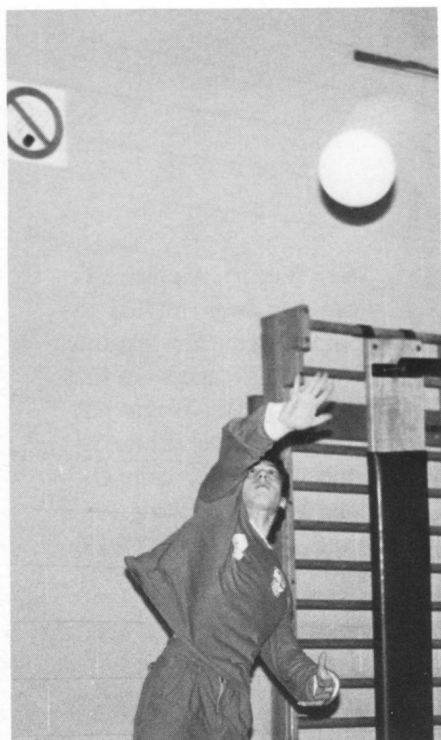

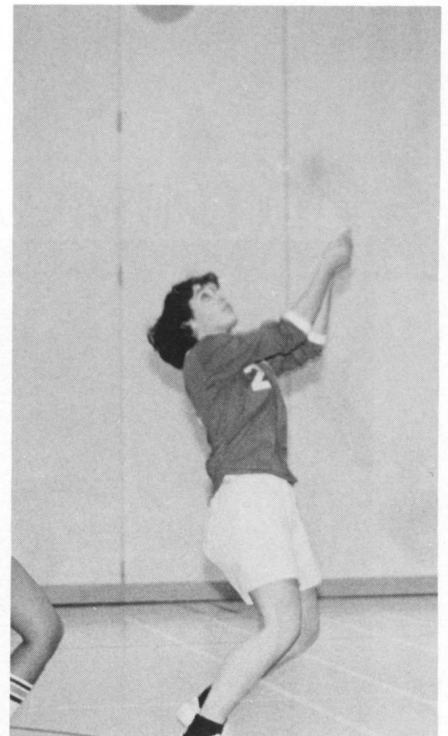

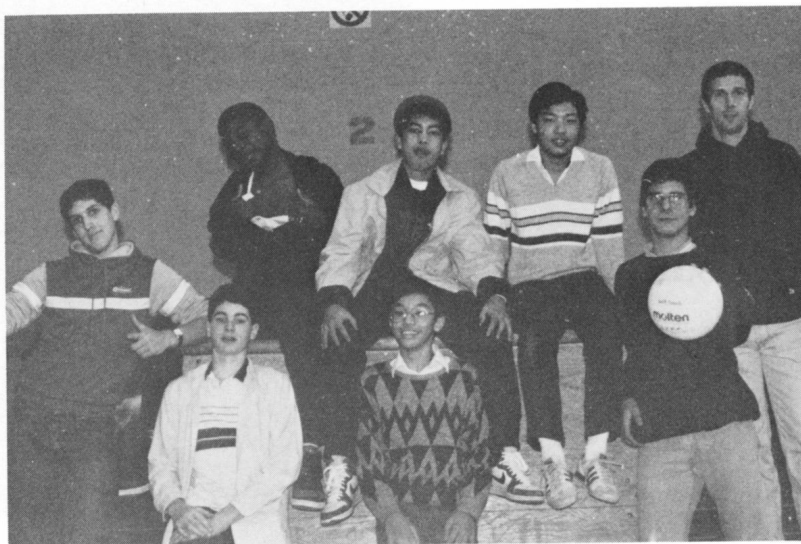

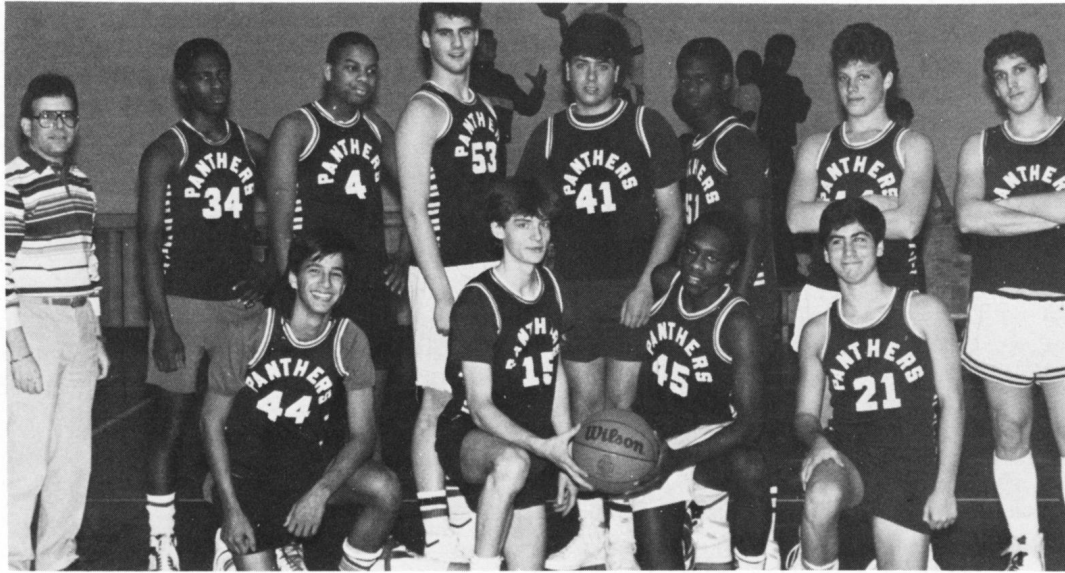
JUVENILE BOYS' BADMINTON

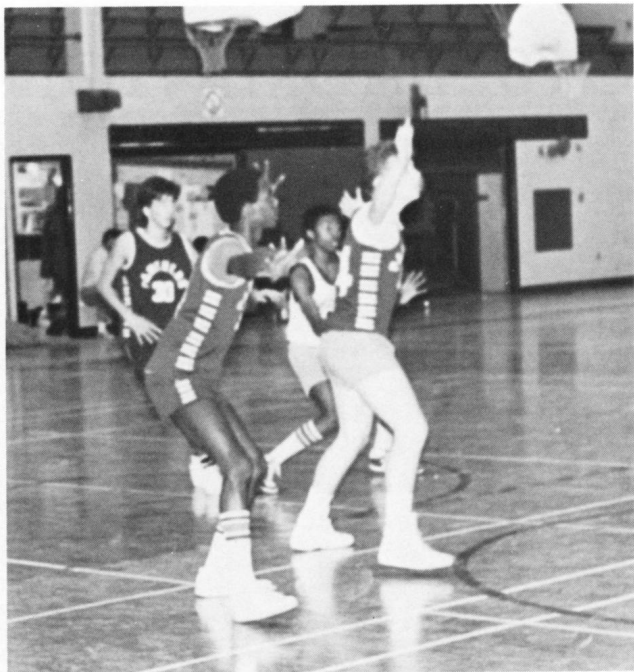
