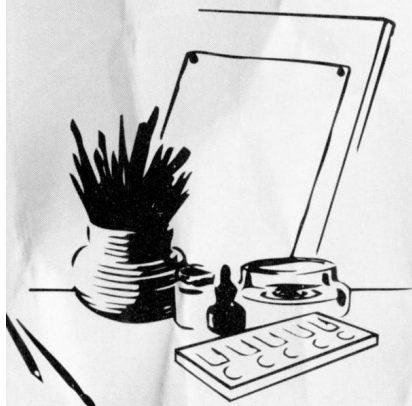
Mr F. Smith
