PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

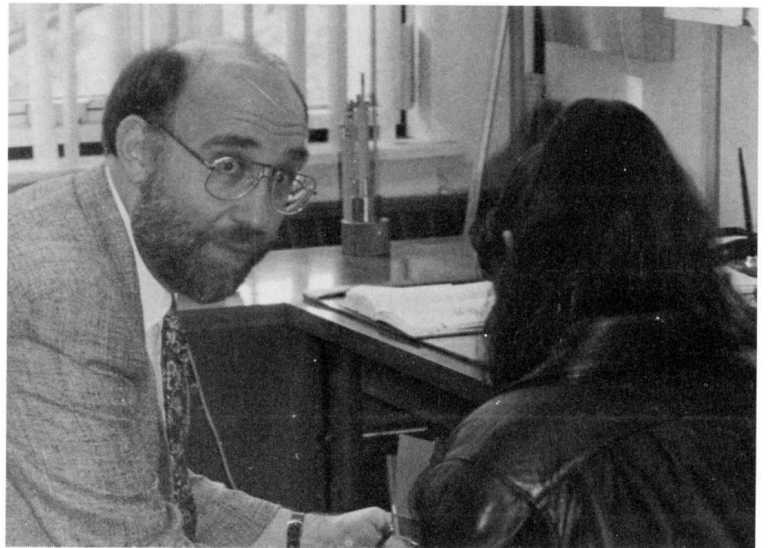
Dear graduates,
